Elder High School is a high school that is in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. As is the Archdiocese, Elder is dedicated to provide the safest possible environment for the children under its care.

The process to become a volunteer at Elder High School:

- All volunteers must have a selection.com background check. Volunteers can execute their applications from home without having to drive anywhere.
- All volunteers must attend a VIRTUS training class and complete the monthly "Protecting God's Children for Adults" bulletins.
- All volunteers must understand the Archdiocese of Cincinnati's Decree on Child Protection, which can be viewed at:

To complete the background check and schedule a VIRTUS training class, all you need to do is go to www.VIRTUS.org. Because the processes have been streamlined, you can schedule both on the same site. The one-time selection.com fee is \$25. There is no fee for the VIRTUS training.
